COST: \$25 per person (shoe rental separate)

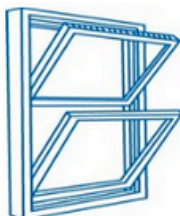
FORMAT: Three games of 9-8-7 pin no tap bowling. Individual scratch bowling, after bowling is complete all scores will be totaled and then divided into 3 equal flights. Each flight will be paid the same. Number of places paid depends on # of entries. All ties will have a special roll off. **THERE ARE CASH PAYOUTS!**

****There are typically around 50 bowlers. 9,8,7 no tap means in game one if you hit 9 out of 10 pins, it counts as a strike. In game two if you hit 8 out of 10 pins, it counts as a strike. In game 3 if you hit 7 out of 10 pins, it counts as a strike. There are typically a lot of strikes in game 3. Thank you for your consideration for this great cause!
