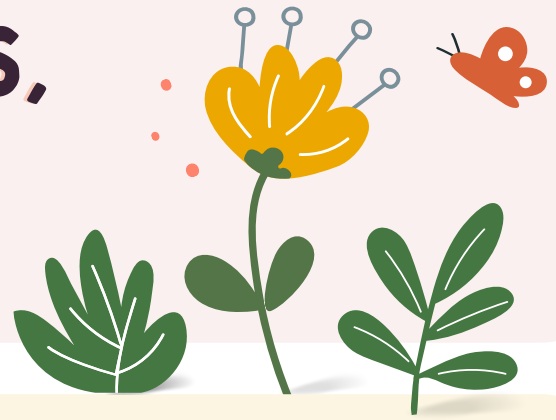

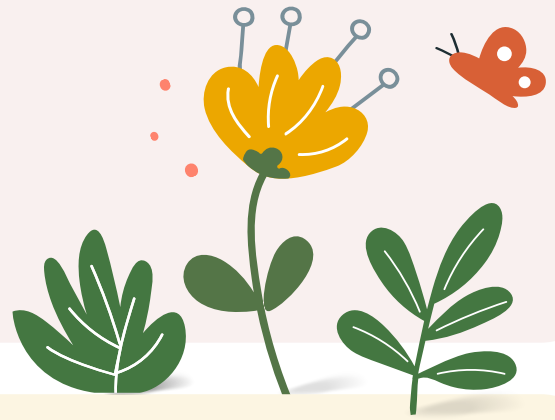


This training prepares volunteers to represent the best interests of children who have experienced abuse and neglect within the juvenile court system—ensuring their voices are heard when they need it most.

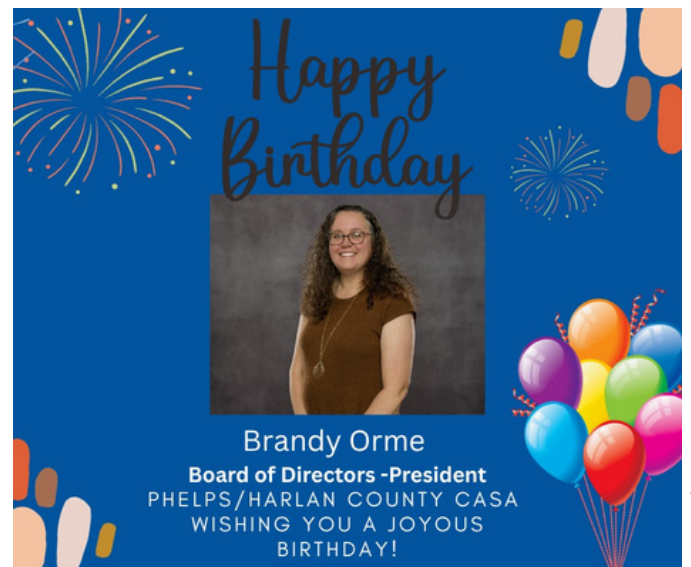
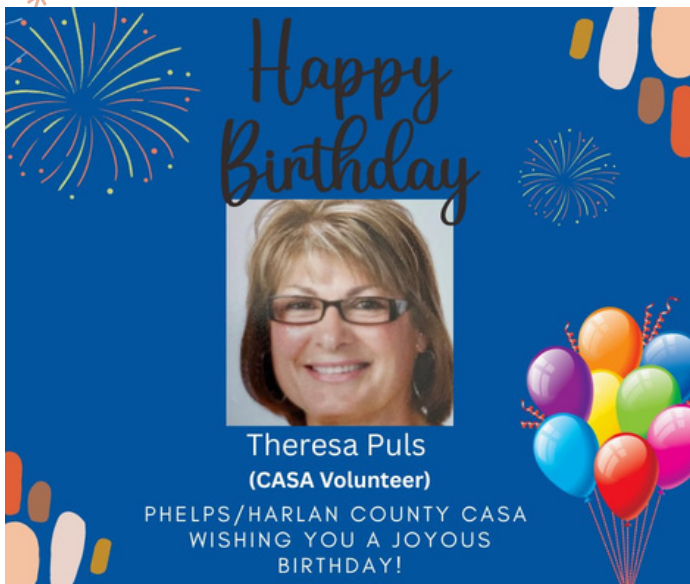

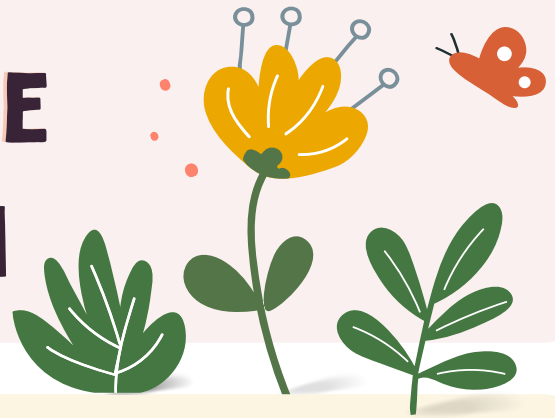

APRIL IS CHILD ABUSE AWARENESS MONTH



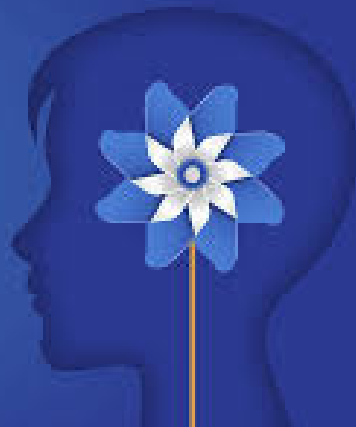
April 1st marks the beginning of Child Abuse Awareness Month — a time to come together as a community to support and protect children.

Together, we can help create a safer, stronger future for children in our community

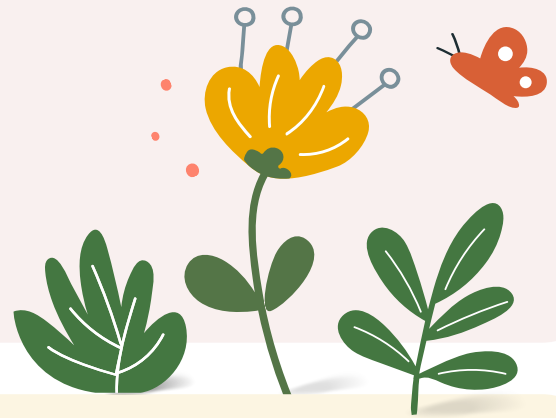

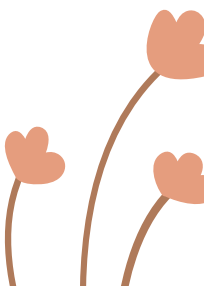
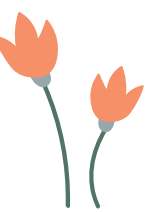
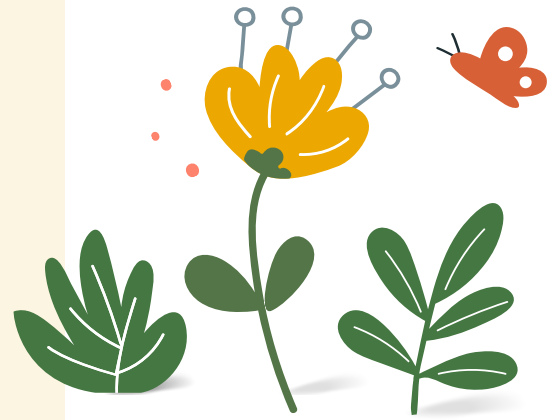
PINWHEELS FOR PREVENTION



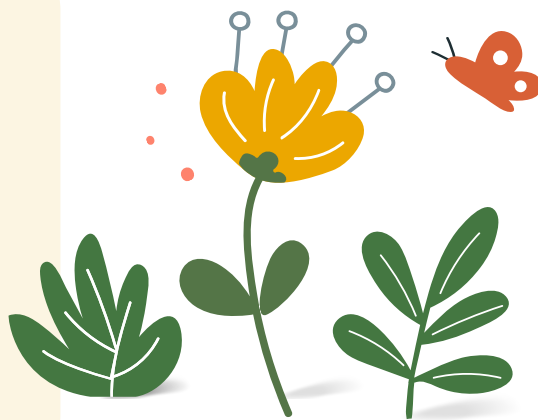

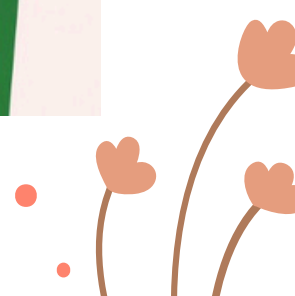
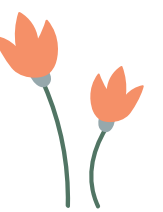
